

Sherwood Band Boosters BLUE BAG Fundraiser

Thank you for supporting Sherwood Band Boosters. Sherwood Band Boosters support all band and color guard programs at the middle and high school levels. BLUE BAGS are an easy way to support our band program. Simply fill your bag with recyclables and drop them off at convenient locations surrounding Sherwood.

For anyone not familiar with our BLUE BAG fundraiser, here are commonly asked questions.

What are BLUE BAGS?

BLUE BAGS are to collect all your REFUNDABLE recyclables. Mix cans, bottles and plastics up in one bag! (20 pound limit)

What is redeemable?

Any beverage container with an Oregon refund value noted on it is redeemable. All containers must have the brand name and / or the OR10 marking legible to be credited.

(Containers purchased OUTSIDE of Oregon are NOT refundable, even if the OR10 refund value is on the label.)

Do I have to remove the lids?

NO! All plastic lids are fine! The only exception are metal lids, such as those found on energy drinks. *Metal lids are not allowed in the BLUE BAGS.*

Can I put crushed cans in the BLUE BAGS?

NO! Crushed cans clog the machinery. All crushed cans can be brought to the Customer Service desk to be manually counted and credited to our account. Reference Sherwood Band Boosters as our fundraiser name.

What is BLUE BAG common etiquette?

Please be sure redeemed containers are empty and most importantly, please, no waste and no trash in the BLUE BAGS.

Where do I drop off my BLUE BAGS?
